Important migration information and checklist:

- Handle links will remain the same. Please note that these links at this point in time still points to the articles on <http://reference.sabinet.co.za>. These links will be updated later in the year to point to the articles on www.journals.co.za. We will keep you informed when this is updated.
- Change any links referring to http://reference.sabinet.co.za/sa_epublications to www.journals.co.za in your libguides, on your intranet, your library webpage, student portals etc.
e.g. http://reference.sabinet.co.za/sa_epublications_a_z change to <http://www.journals.co.za/content/publications>
- Change any links to journal pages. Please visit www.journals.co.za/librarian-resources to get a list of the new URLs for specific journals.
- Update any links from your own Discovery Tools e.g. EBSCO Discovery and Millennium Encore to point to www.journals.co.za
- We will endeavour to seamlessly redirect all SA ePublications links to our current platform (<http://reference.sabinet.co.za>) to our new Platform (<http://www.journals.co.za>). Redirects to the new platform will be implemented early December 2016 and will be completed by the end of December 2016. Should you experience any problems as from January 2017 please immediately notify us.
